To help Dartmoor Livestock – PONIES, SHEEP or CATTLE – collapsed, sick, trapped, live lamb by dead ewe, etc. and for sheep worrying/ dog attacks

DISTRESS/INJURY

☞ **IMPORTANT – PLEASE GIVE THESE DETAILS:**

1. TYPE OF ANIMAL: colour, dye marks, brand letters, ear marks, special features?
 2. WHAT APPEARS WRONG: pain, collapsed, bleeding?
 3. LOCATION: ...clear directions VITAL... is animal visible from road, mobile? give grid reference if possible
 4. CAN YOU STAY TO GUIDE ASSISTANCE? ...this is very helpful.
 5. YOUR NAME, TEL. No. & ADDRESS: could be vital for additional directions etc
- WARNING: AVOID HANDLING A LAMB**
(often only apparently deserted) as ewe may reject it.
